

ORDINANCE NO. 17B

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING INCREASE IN WATER AND SEWER CHARGES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO:

Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to increase water and sewer system fees and rates which were previously adopted on January 1, 2006.

Section 2. ADDITION TO ORDINANCES 94A AND 10B. The Town of Stratton has previously adopted Ordinance 94A regarding sewer service regulations, and Ordinance 10B, concerning failure to pay water and sewer charges of the Town of Stratton. The Town of Stratton also adopted a monthly usage schedule for water and sewer fees on January 1, 2006. Ordinances 94A and 10B shall remain in full force and effect, along with the rate schedule adopted on January 1, 2006, except that the residential and commercial water and sewer rates shall be changed, and increased as follows:

RESIDENT:

Residential Water- One Unit - \$20.00 per month

Commercial Water - One Unit - \$33.00 per month

Residential Sewer- One Unit - \$18.00 per month

Commercial Sewer - One Unit - \$28.00 per month

NON-RESIDENT:

Residential Water- One Unit - \$33.00 per month

Commercial Water - One Unit - \$45.50 per month

Residential Sewer - One Unit - \$28.00 per month

Commercial Sewer - One Unit - \$38.00 per month

Section 3. NECESSITY OF INCREASED WATER AND SEWER RATES. The above-described increased water and sewer rates are deemed necessary by the Town Council of the Town of Stratton, Colorado in order to pay for necessary maintenance and improvements to the water and sewer systems, and to obtain grant funds from all sources available.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE OF AMENDMENT . The Board of Trustees declares that the increased water and sewer rates shall be effective July 1, 2006.
