

ORDINANCE NO. 18-A

AN ORDINANCE RAISING THE WATER TAPPING FEES AND CHARGES AND RAISING CONSUMER RATES FOR WATER FOR THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO, AMENDING SECTION 2 OR ORDINANCE 12-A AND SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 4-A RESPECTIVELY, OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the Town of stratton finds that because of increased costs of labor and materials and other inflationary pressures, it is necessary to discontinue the practice of furnishing labor and materials incident to tapping of water lines and to raise consumer rates for water;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF STRATTON, KIT CARSON COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 12-A of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, is hereby amended to read as amended as follows:

In the event that the consumer's application for a water tap is required by Section 1 of said Ordinance No. 12-A of the Town of Stratton is approved as therein set forth, the applicant shall be so notified, and thereupon the applicant shall pay to to the Town Clerk the sum of \$150.00 tapping fee for each water tap fee applied for, and in addition thereto shall pay all charges for labor performed and materials, except the meter, used in effecting each hookup. In the event that water is already piped to the property, and the applicant desires to change the water tap, the the applicant shall pay only the charges for labor and materials used in effecting the change in the water tap but shall not be required to pay the \$150.00 tapping fee.

Section 2. Section 7 or Ordinance No. 4-A of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Rate: (a) Rates to resident consumers shall be as follows: For the first 3,000 gallons of water consumed, the rate shall be \$7.00 per unit. for all water consumed in excess of 3,000 gallons, the rate shall be \$.30 per 1,000 gallons consumed per unit.

(b) Rates to non-resident consumers shall be as follows: For the first 3,000 gallons consumed, the rate shall be \$10.00 per unit. For all water consumed in excess of 3,000 gallons, the rate shall be \$.45 per 1,000 gallons consumed per unit.

(c) The term "unit" means a single family residential unit, and, where two or more units are in one building, the above rates apply to each unit whether billed separately or collectively.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees finds and declares that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, affects the public peace, health and safety, and therefore, an emergency exists, and that this Ordinance shall become effective five (five) days after the publication thereof.
