ORDINANCE NO. 62A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET AND 1993 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON AND DECLARING THE "STRATTON COMMUNITY BUILDING" AND ENTERPRISE UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON.

Whereas, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is for the best interests of the citizens of the Town of Stratton that the "Stratton Community Building" be declared to be an enterprise under the control of the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton, and

Whereas, the 1993 Budget and the 1993 Appropriation Ordinance should be amended to include the "Stratton Community Building" as an enterprise of the Town of Stratton.

NOW, THEREFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The "Stratton Community Building" is an "enterprise" or "government owned business" having income from rentals and donations and having expenses for maintenance and utilities and repairs and capital improvements owned and operated by the Town of Stratton, supervised, controlled, and governed by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton.

SECTION 2. The 1993 Budget and the 1993 Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

RECLASSIFY BUDGET: GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES

Transfer to "Community Building Enterprise Fund-----3,600

RECLASSIFY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 60A., SECTION 1:

STRATTON COMMUNITY BUILDING ENTERPRISE FUND:

Current Operating Expenses-----	3,600
Capital Outlay-----	3,000
Total Community Building Fund-----	6,600

INCREASE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 60A :TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS---550,169

SECTION 3. The Board of Trustees finds and declares that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and therefore, an emergency exists, and this ordinance, shall be recorded in the Book Of Ordinances of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and attested by the Town Clerk under the corporate seal of the Town and shall be published within the corporate limits of the Town and shall be published in the "Stratton Spotlight", a public weekly

newspaper published within the corporate limits of the Town of Stratton and the County of Kit Carson and the State of Colorado and shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
