

ORDINANCE NO. 64-A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 29-A OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO, PROVIDING FOR THE CUTTING AND REMOVAL OF WEEDS, BRUSH AND RUBBISH FROM LOTS IN THE TOWN OF STRATTON, TO CHANGE THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Whereas, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is for the best interests of the citizens and the general welfare of the Town of Stratton that the specific penalty set forth in Ordinance No. 29-A be changed to the General Penalty Ordinance No. 58-A, now therefore,

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO,
ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 29-A is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

"Section 7. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished according to the General Penalty Ordinance No. 58-A of the Town of Stratton, Colorado."

SECTION 2. The Board of Trustees finds and declares that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and, therefore, an emergency exists, and this ordinance shall be recorded in the Book of Ordinances of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and attested by the Town Clerk under the corporate seal of the Town and shall be published in the "Stratton Spotlight", a public weekly newspaper published within the corporate limits of the Town of Stratton and the County of Kit Carson and State of Colorado and shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
