### ACCESS TERMS & RULES

No refunds will be made on access fees. All members are expected to abide by the rules and standards of conduct established by the Stratton Town Board. Any member who misuses the equipment or does not abide by the posted rules or standard of conduct is subject to loss of access.

I am/we are participating at the Stratton Activities Center (SAC) for my/our recreation and recognize that injuries can occur. I am/we are under no obligation by the SAC to use the facility. I/we further acknowledge that I/we will observe and follow SAC rules and policy. In consideration of the SAC allowing me/us to use the facility, I/we hereby waive and release the SAC, ownership, employees and instructors from all liability for any and all damages and injuries suffered by myself/us in connection with said use of this facility.

The Town of Stratton reserves the rights to amend modify or change rules and/or policies at anytime without notice, which are to be binding to all previous active agreements. Membership is renewable monthly upon payment of fees.

- 1 You must pay all fees in advance. (There is a \$5.00 deposit on all cards, with a \$10.00 replacement fee for lost cards)
- 2 Access is restricted to cardholders and children under their guardianship, high school age and under. Children must be under the parent's direct supervision at all times.
- 3 A family membership holder may take one other card-holding family's children to the SAC with them.
- 4 A member may purchase up to five guest passes daily at a cost of \$5.00 per pass, per day. Guest must be present with the primary or secondary member to access the building. If you allow someone else in the building that does not have an access card, or purchased a guest pass, or loan your access card, your membership can be revoked. All appeals will be heard before the Stratton Town Board of Trustees.
- 5 Access cards and their activities are tracked and the building is under video/audio surveillance.
- 6 Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, bats, baseballs, golf clubs and golf balls, hockey sticks and pucks are not allowed inside the building. Roller skates, and roller blades, are allowed.
- 7 Children with appropriate adult supervision may use equipment not in use by adults. Adult cardholders have priority on all equipment, and children are required to yield use of equipment to adults.
- 8 Cardholders, and their children, use the facility and all equipment at their own risk and are expected to utilize the equipment properly and not to abuse it.
- 9 Cardholders are expected to clean up after themselves, and to help keep the facility clean and orderly.
- 10 Restricted times may occur without notice, if the entire building is rented out or being used for a special event.
- 11 If you or your children break or destroy any part of the building or the equipment because of negligence or abuse you will be held financially responsible for repair or replacement.
